- Since February 2021 I have been collaborating with a highly complex private hospital with an agreement, where I mainly follow vertebral and urological and orthopedic surgery
- Since May 2020 I have been collaborating, always as a Freelancer, at the Anesthesia Service e Resuscitation of a public hospital, with a contract expiring next May 2021.
- From September 2016 to now, expert collaborator at a private affiliated structure in Emilia Romagna: I mainly deal with orthopedic surgery and spinal neurosurgery, without neglecting other specialist surgeries (general, vascular, urological)
- Since March 2016 collaborator, continuously, in a freelance regime, at a private Clinic

- affiliated in Veneto (until May 2019), and from September 2016 also at a private Clinic in Emilia Romagna: I mainly deal with orthopedic surgery and neurosurgery vertebral, without neglecting other specialist surgery (general, vascular, urological).
- I also resumed outpatient antalgic therapy in Emilia Romagna, at the Centro di Medicina, ex- Ferrara Day Surgery in Ferrara. Ù
- From January 2013 to July 2016 I worked full time as *an anesthesiologist chosen* by the Director of the Department of Orthopedics and Traumatology of the Hospital of Suzzara SpA (MN), dealing with the large part of elective orthopedic surgery, prosthetic knee, hip, shoulder; arthroscopic ankle, shoulder, knee and hip, of the minor one and of traumatology at all levels. In this structure I am the contact person for the Pcs pertaining to the same surgeon, for antalgic management protocols and in a broader sense, of *Perioperative Medecin*.
- For some years I have been collaborating with professional dentistry studies where I practice light-moderate analgosedation with capnometric-graphic monitoring in plastic, ENT and dental surgery (Dr. Stefano Spaggiari, Parma), primarily for sharing professional views and personal esteem), with extreme satisfaction of colleagues, patients that I follow and my staff, having a solid and accurate experience
- From 1st September 2009, freelancer, working in an important and accredited Private Clinic in Emilia Romagna (Casa di Cura Città di Partma) affiliated, mainly engaged in orthopedic prosthetic knee and hip surgery, sports traumatology, endoscopic and non-endoscopic shoulder surgery, in open and obstetric-gynecological surgery laparoscopic (Prof Calestani, Dr. Benatti), *partoanalgesia* with Ropivacaine and Levubupivacaine; neurosurgery endoscopic spinal (anesthetist chosen contact person for Dr.Andrea Fontanella, Italian representative of the *ISMISS*, www.ismiss.com), general wide-ranging surgery, urological surgery, (Dr. Simonazzi), endoscopic and open, *bariatric surgery* (Bending VLA, biliodigestive diversion, gastric by-pass), orl (*FESS*, *chosen anesthesiologist of reference* (Dr. Vignali, www.chirurgianaso.it), plastic surgery
- July 2003-August 2008 in service as Medical Director at the Anesthesia Operating Unit Resuscitation of the Neuroscience Department of the Bellaria Hospital "CA Pizzardi" in Bologna (Intracranial neurosurgery also vascular and in emergency-emergency; thoracic surgery also pneumectomie; major plastic and reconstructive surgery, general surgery)
- November 2002-July 2003, service as Medical Director at the Anesthesia and Resuscitation Service of the Sant'Anna University Hospital in Ferrara (PS, AG, ALR subarachnoid activity, peripheral nerve blocks at all levels)

- In 2017 I was invited to hold a *16 hour ECM accredited course*, entitled: "Management of Pain", at an important structure with which I work as a freelancer in Emilia
- In 2019, I was invited as teacher for a Intensive Course for nurses, ECM accredited, entitled "The Breathing of patient: recognize it, support it and eventually

## replace it".(AGENAS)

 I stress that I have never participated in interventions of Voluntary Terminations of Pregnancy (IVG), for personal ethical reasons, as I consider the termination of human pregnancy not clinical-medical. However, I followed the reference surgery for IVG weekly, therefore knowing the typology and motivations of the afferent women and trying, most of the time, to convince mothers to keep the unborn child, as required by law "194" In Italy.

#### PREFERENCE PERFORMANCE:

Personally, I consider the general anesthesia for DAY SURGERY , the so-called "fast-track anesthesia", very promising. Total awareness and control of intravenous anaesthesia (TIVA: total intravenous anesthesia ) or mixed (Sevofluoran and Remifentanyl) drugs: times limited hospitalization, postoperative side effects, nausea and vomiting in particular, drastically reduced if not canceled, good control of postoperative pain.

Particularly fond of BLENDED ANAESTHESIA, associating deep sedation in LMA, without curarization, with ALR (both central and peripheral blocks).

Wide experience and confidence with special principals, such as FAST-TRACK, Disposcope, FBS, LMA, Videolaryngoscopes.

<u>Peripheral blocks</u>: brachial plexus block through the interscalene and axillary route, sciatic-femoral block via posterior and anterior, positioning of perineural catheters (CPN) routinely (via ENS); I have followed courses for learn Eco-guided blocks at the Rizzoli Orthopedic Institute in Bologna, but,personally, I consider it very precise the technique via Electroneurostimulator, moreover faster, and certainly less annoying, if in expert hands of anatomy, compared to the ultrasound-guided technique.

<u>Central blocks</u>: excellent experience with subarachnoid anesthesia, with very thin needles (27 gauge), excellent experience with the positioning of peridural catheters, mainly used for thoracic surgery, general and for labor pain analgesia. Preferably I use 25G pencilpoint needles Whitacre. <u>Central venous catheterization</u> for parenteral nutrition: posterior and anterior access via jugular vein internal, Succlavio access.

Excellent experience however with general anesthesia, both inhalation and balanced (almost absolute use of the only route intravenous for important reasons from the scientific point of sale). *Extensive experience with deep sedation in spontaneous breathing, extremely delicate procedure* that requires specific expertise with capnographic monitoring, used for supine position procedures (AAII arthroscopies, inguinal hernioplastics, hemorrhoidectomies, cystoscopies, hysteroscopies, venous stripping, breast biopsies ...) but **also prone** (mainly vertebroplasty, but also pilonodal cysts, interventions on the forearm ...) **always in extreme safety.** 

Total management of intraoperative monitoring, BIS, NMT, ENTROPIA included.

Excellent *Intensivological experience*, in particular in invasive and non-invasive mechanical ventilation assistance.

Passionate about *Analgesic and Pain Therapy*, for three years I managed a DH clinic in the facility where I served in Parma, treating both acute and chronic, benign and oncological pain. I also transferred my experience in the perioperative management of orthopedic and non-

orthopedic patients to the Hospital of Suzzara (MN).

### FOREIGN LANGUAGES AND COMPUTER KNOWLEDGE:

Excellent knowledge of both English and French, spoken and written (June-July 1989: intensive English language course at the Center of Stratford upon Avon-England), which were followed in Italy by two English courses in 1995 and 1999 respectively at two language schools recognized; seven-month fellowship in New York in 2000).

I'm taking an accredited German course, that will bring me a first level of knowledge (A1) Excellent knowledge of Windows programs; excellent confidence in internet browsing.

## **HOBBIES AND PERSONAL INTERESTS:**

I have practiced many sports at an amateur level: basketball, tennis, skiing, cycling, triathlon, running race. I also really enjoy bringing small sailing boats, I practiced surfing as a kid.

I recently deepened the APNEA, with courses at the *Apnea Academy founded by Umberto Pelizzari*; apnea understood as relaxation and breathing method, to rediscover your own relaxation, self-knowledge and your limit, to learn to measure yourself with caution and common sense in potentially anxiety-provoking situations.

In addition to sport, my interests are primarily my wife and three children; hang out with my friends as much as possible and acquaintances; reading, cinema.

In the past I have committed myself as a non - registered volunteer at AIDO: I held meetings in high schools for the knowledge of the clinical-diagnostic pathway leading to the diagnosis of death e the possible removal of organs; I have participated as a *speaker also in First Aid courses* held at volunteering (January 2002) and at the CRI headquarters in Ferrara (May 2001) and I have held reports in accredited courses ECM at the hospital companies where I worked.

In 2012 I was *invited as a speaker to the congress of the National Association of Breast Operated Women (ANDOS) of Parma*, with whom I collaborate (Dr. Montanari Marzio): awarded with the "Silver Swallow". In 2019 I held course for nurses, ECM Agenas accredited, on the importance of function evaluation respiratory during analgosedation and general anesthesia, to ensure safety in the operating room and understand in useful time the risks associated with the situation in the operating room.
